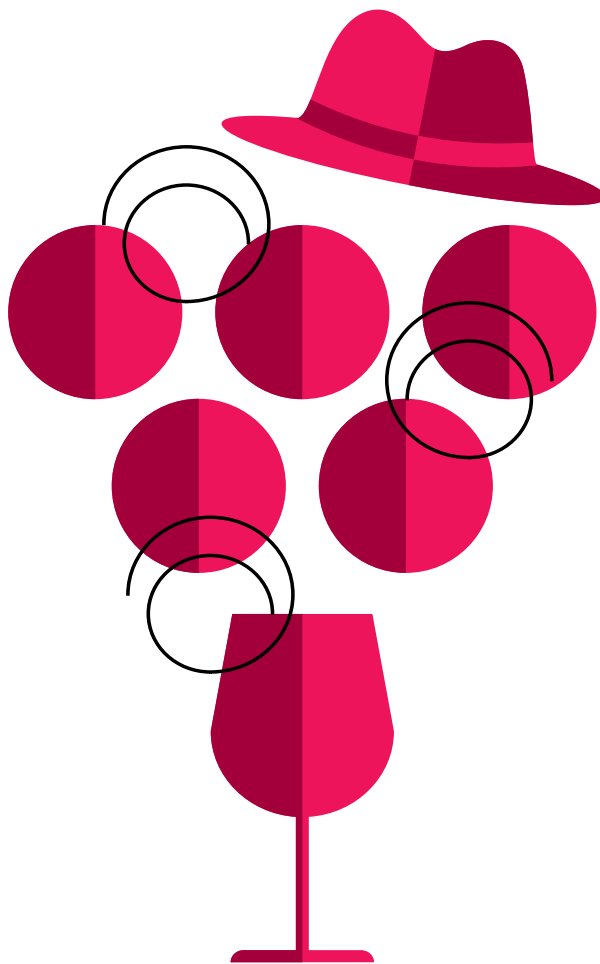

Slow Wine

The annual Slow Wine guide, published by Slow Food Editore, adopts a new approach to wine criticism: not only reviews and organoleptic descriptions but a real wine storytelling where the deep and direct knowledge of the wine companies is the one and only protagonist. We visit all cellars and take into consideration the wine quality, adherence to terroir, value for money and give greater weight and importance to the estates' production methods. Through the guide and international tour we support and promote small-scale Italian winemakers who are using traditional techniques, working with respect for the environment, and safeguarding the incredible biodiversity of grape varieties that are part of Italy's heritage.

I Vini del Piemonte

I Vini del Piemonte is a consortium of promotion that includes some 200 Piedmontese wine companies. The aim is to promote and communicate in the best way possible the richness and peculiarities of the different Piedmontese wine designations. Every year, the consortium organizes more than 30 promotional initiatives in different countries around the world.

Meaning of the partnership between Slow Wine and I Vini del Piemonte

Slow Food started out almost thirty years ago in Piedmont. Despite the exponential growth of members worldwide and the huge spread of Carlo Petrini's ideas, its headquarters remain in Bra, a small Piedmontese town. Its heart still beats in Piedmont and the first events were centred on the wine of this region. Slow Food believes that wine, just as with food, must be “good, clean, and fair”—not just good. Wine is an agricultural product, just like any of the foods we eat, and has an impact on the lives of the people who produce it, as well as on the environment—through pesticides, herbicides and excessive water consumption which are all commonplace in conventional wine production.

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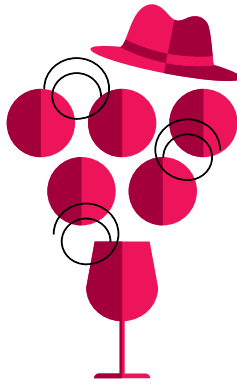

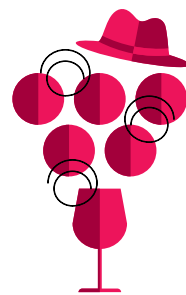

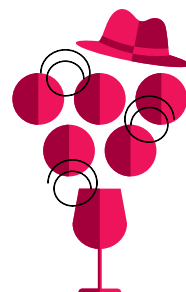

Our family-run estate is located on the renowned Loreto Aprutino hills, under the Apennines' highest mountain, the Gran Sasso, and just 20 km from the Adriatic Sea. In a celebrated fresco in town representing the Judgment Day, the "torre dei beati" (tower of the blessed) is the final goal that the souls try to reach through hard trials. For us, that's a metaphor for the hard selection that all our grapes have to overcome before resulting in our wines. We have been certified organic since 1999, and we only grow the native traditional grape varieties Montepulciano, Pecorino and Trebbiano. All our bottles come from our 21-hectare vineyard.

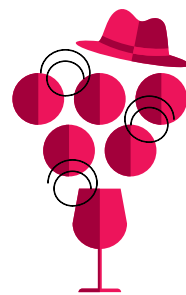

It all began when Felice, a cattle breeder who had moved to France to explore the hidden mysteries of the transalpine tradition, decided to undertake a long journey back to Italy, collecting encounters, experiences, and flavors rooted in centuries of history. 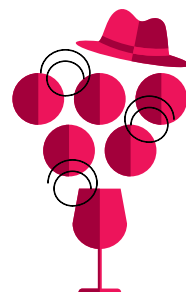

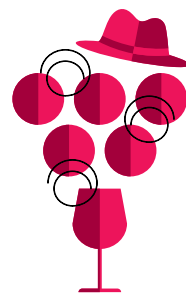

Selva Capuzza is a small farm dedicated to producing wines exclusively from 6 indigenous grape varieties. The Estate is located 4 km south of Lake Garda's coast in a very precious area where three wine appellations overlap each other: Garda Classico, San Martino della Battaglia and Lugana. Here the climate is gentle, and moderated by the lake, there are many olive trees, a wood which was an old truffle plantation, wide open spaces dedicated to biodiversity, a park with mulberry trees. 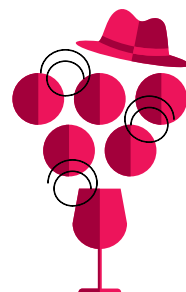

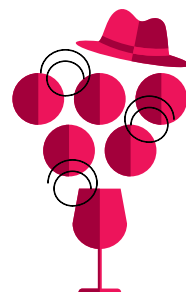

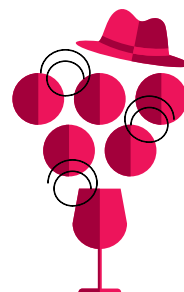

The exceptional limestone and gypsum soil on the slopes of Monte Orfano, is the magical and peculiar ingredient of this strip of Franciacorta, where the vines draw the rich salts from the earth deep down. Sudden climatic and pedological variations create a mosaic of micro-zones in a few hectares, which the winemakers have been able to exploit wisely, also through the restoration of forgotten vineyards, such as CruPerdu. In Castello Bonomi, uniqueness is then further enhanced by visionary and courageous cellar choices, ahead of their time like the creation of the first Franciacorta rosé with 100% Pinot Noir grapes.

Originally from the Alta Langa area, the Adriano family have been farmers. In the 1960s they settled in the area of San Rocco Seno d'Elvio, fraction of the village Alba, where they still are today. The decision to invest in agriculture, in difficult times when anyone would have chosen the city life with no doubt, was courageous and paid off successfully. In 1994 the modern history of the winery began, with the brothers Vittorio and Marco, together with their wives Grazia and Luciana. The Adriano winery is located in the valley of Seno d'Elvio, the only part of Alba still in the Barbaresco area of production. It is in the southernmost part of the denomination, in the close vicinity of the town of Alba, but totally distant from the chaotic atmosphere of the city.

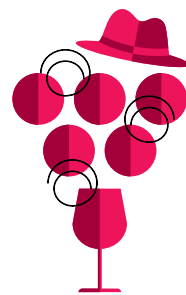

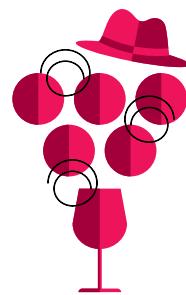

Borgogno is the most historical winery in Barolo, since 1761. The protagonist was Cesare Borgogno, who decided in 1920 to forget half of Barolo Riserva production in the cellar and selling it almost 20 years later. The result is a largest collection of the greatest vintages of Barolo, and since this intuition, the most important Borgogno tradition began, getting rich over the time by three historical crus in Barolo: Cannubi, Liste, Fossati, which are Barolo single-vineyards. Wines are made in full respect of tradition: long and spontaneous fermentation in concrete and long aging in large Slavonian oak barrels. We cultivate our vineyards in Barolo, Madonna di Como and Colli Tortonesi for the Timorasso. Since 2019 we have the certification of organic agriculture.

We are in Verduno. From the logo, the Diego Morra winery tells its values. At the heart of it all, a stylized V represents Verduno; the three intertwined M speak of the Morra family, of the Mosca farmhouse and of Monvigliero, the most famous Barolo mention in Verduno, of which the winery owns 4 hectares in three different exposures. 32 hectares of owned vineyards between Verduno, La Morra and Roddi: 14 hectares are cultivated with Nebbiolo to make Barolo into 10 different “cru/MGA”. 70,000 bottles produced, selecting the best grapes from 32 hectares. 11 labels are currently produced, but the most representative of Diego Morra wines are certainly the Verduno Pelaverga DOC, a small native vine, and the very elegant and intense Barolos.

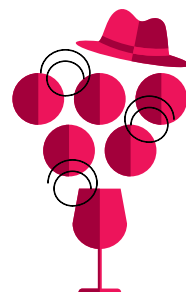

DonnaLia is a winery situated in the province of Biella, Northern Piedmont, resting on the Moraine hills of the Serra of Ivrea in San Secondo, Salussola, with vineyards positioned 300 meters above sea level. The winery falls within the area of the Canavese DOC, which greatly benefits from the microclimate of the nearby Lake Viverone, who's excellent sun exposure and unusual glacial soil assists the overall growing process. The wines of the Canavese share common characteristics. All are influenced by a mild temperature, combined with the constant benefit of general ventilation from the nearby Valdostan Alps and by strong diurnal/nocturnal thermal excursions especially during the pre-harvest period. In all wine types, there is a particularly good acidity and sapidity with a low polyphenolic content.

La Spinetta was founded by Pin and Lidia Rivetti, expert farmers with huge appreciation and knowledge for tradition and interest in the future. In the '77, Carlo, Bruno, Giorgio, and Giovanna took over the winery reins, working to implement the teachings of their parents, great respect for the territory, for the indigenous vines and for the land. This is when the first production of single-cru Moscato began. With the success of our Moscato business, we decided to branch out and focus on red grapes as Barbera and Nebbiolo. In 2001 a new winery was built in Tuscany; they wanted the challenge of working in a different territory with different indigenous grape varieties, such as Sangiovese. 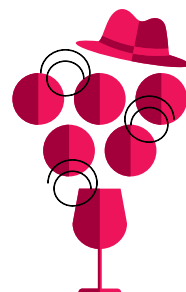

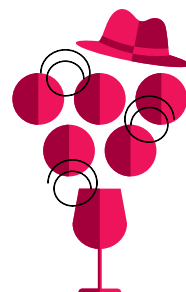

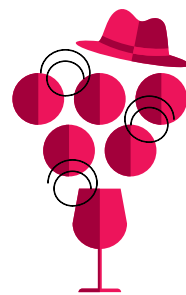

The turning point came when Bruno proposed to his family that they no longer sell the grapes, which were always poorly paid, but to equip a cellar to vinify and bottle the wine, however produced with fewer bunches per vine to favor its maturation. A simple idea, which today may seem trivial, but was revolutionary in these parts at the time. “Pruvuma” (let’s try) was the only word said by father Fiorenzo. The atmosphere one breathes in the thousand-year-old abbey of San Lorenzo at Coltibuono mingles with the modernity of the new Monti cellar to create a new amalgam that gives wines classicism and modernity, elegance and drinkability. Most of the vineyards are situated in the Monti district with some parcels in Vitignano.

Las Abejas is a concept winery that was started based on choosing the best possible piece of land for growing grapes in anticipation of climate change. Their search alighted on a piece of land in the high elevation Valle de Ojos Negros in Baja California, located just south and slightly inland from Valle de Guadalupe. Priority was placed on organic certification since the beginning, and the vineyards are certified organic by the CCOF. All grapes in their wines come from estate vineyards. 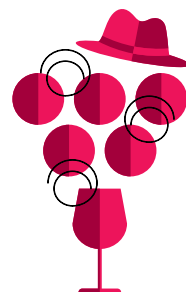

We use four basic processes executed with zero technological intervention - pressed by foot, inviting wild fermentation with no industrial yeast or sugars added, macerated in buried clay vessels and hand pressed with rustic utensils. Our wine is fermented for up to 9 months in buried clay pots molded by local San Felipe and Dolores Hidalgo artisans. The process of sourcing these vessels brought about the revival of ancestral methods of making pottery - a tradition almost lost in time in a compromise for a quicker way of making pottery that satisfies mass demand. We have tried to recreate the classic Georgian kvevri form, and ended up with a hybrid that has a particular Mexican imprint. We are happy with how our clay pots turned out, it is our belief they're the reason our wines have a very particular character, unique to our winery.
